**AVAILABILITY:** Available to all small commercial consumers that record 50 KW or

less. Subject to the Cooperative's established rules and

regulations.

**TYPE OF SERVICE:** Single Phase and Three Phase, 60 hertz, at available secondary

voltages.

**RATE:** Daily Grid Charge \$1.35

All KWH used \$0.09731

MINIMUM CHARGE: The minimum monthly charge under the above rate(s) shall be

the consumer availability charge plus all applicable taxes, or the minimum monthly charge established in an Agreement for

Purchase of Power, WHICHEVER IS LARGER.

## **CONDITIONS OF SERVICE:**

The rated capacity of single phase motors shall not be in excess of 10 HP. Motors having a rated capacity in excess of 10 HP must be 3 phase.

In those cases where it is necessary to extend or reinforce distribution lines, service will be furnished only under the following conditions:

## **CONTINUITY OF SERVICE:**

The Cooperative shall use reasonable diligence to provide a constant and uninterrupted supply of electric power and energy, but if such supply shall fail or be interrupted, or become defective through Act of God, or the public enemy, or by accident, strikes, labor troubles, or by action of the elements, or inability to secure Right-of-Way, or other permits needed, or for any other cause beyond the reasonable control of the Cooperative, the Cooperative shall not be liable therefor.

## TERMS OF PAYMENT AND COLLECTIONS:

Bills are payable upon receipt and delinquent charges, penalties and disconnections shall be in accordance with Cooperative policy.

This rate schedule supersedes all previous rate schedules concerning the types of service indicated.
