The draft Non-unanimous Stipulation and Agreement, which may be filed in this case does not address Issue 13.B.(4) involving whether AmerenMO should be required to eliminate declining block rates for the residential winter energy charge. The Department requests the opportunity to cross-examine AmerenMO witness Wilbon Cooper with respect to his testimony on this issue. Mr. Cooper is the only witness the Department will cross-examine on this issue.
- 3. The Department of Natural Resources respectfully requests that a hearing be conducted tomorrow as scheduled on the issue of declining block rates, even if a Non-unanimous Stipulation and Agreement on rate design is filed today.
