## STIPULATION AND AGREEMENT

September 16, 1988, Citizens Telephone Company of On Higginsville, Missouri (Company) filed a financing application with the Missouri Public Service Commission (Commission) in Case No. During its review in that case, it appeared to the TF-89-60. Commission Staff that Company was experiencing earnings in excess of what might otherwise be a reasonable level of earnings given current Representatives of the Commission Staff and Company circumstances. engaged in discussions concerning the impact of the Federal Tax Reform Act of 1986 on Company's revenue requirements. As a result of these discussions, the parties stipulate and agree as follows:

 That Company shall file tariffs, effective December 1, 1988, which will reduce its monthly local access rates by \$2 per line; the reduction will approximate \$80,000 annually;

2. That this Stipulation and Agreement is a negotiated settlement which is intended to dispose of decreases in Company's gross annual revenue requirement for its Missouri jurisdictional operations due to provisions of the Federal Tax Reform Act of 1986. In addition, Company shall not be further subject to any present or future requirements of the instant docket; it being understood, however, that neither Commission Staff nor any other partv is bound in any proceeding other than the above-captioned docket regarding the effects of the Tax Reform Act on Company's revenue requirement;

3. That this Stipulation and Agreement is intended to be binding on the parties and the Commission for purposes of Commission Case No. A0-87-48 (as it relates to Company); that none of the provisions of this Stipulation and Agreement, however, shall prejudice, bind. or otherwise affect any party should the Commission decide not to approve this Stipulation and Agreement in its entirety or in any way condition its approval of same;

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4. That except as otherwise expressly provided herein, the parties to this Stipulation and Agreement shall not be deemed to have approved of or acquiesced in any expressed or implied ratemaking principle, valuation method, cost of service method, or rate design proposal;

5. That in the event the Commission accepts the specific terms of this Stipulation and Agreement, the parties waive their respective rights to present oral arguments or written briefs, pursuant to Section 536.080(1), RSMo 1986 and their respective rights to judicial review regarding the dispositions of these matters, pursuant to Section 386.510, RSMo 1986;

6. That the agreements contained in this Stipulation and Agreement have resulted from extensive negotiations among the signatory parties and are interdependent; that in the event the Commission does not approve and adopt the terms of this Stipulation and Agreement and in the event the tariffs agreed to herein do not become effective in accordance with the provisions contained herein, this Stipulation and Agreement shall become effective in accordance with the provisions contained herein, this Stipulation and Agreement shall be void and no party shall be bound by any of the agreements or provisions hereof.
