**ORDER EXTENDING TIME IN WHICH TO FILE A PROPOSED  
PROCEDURAL SCHEDULE**

At the prehearing conference held on October 11, 2005, the presiding officer ordered the parties to file a proposed procedural schedule by October 18. On October 18, CenturyTel of Missouri and Spectra Communications filed a motion asking for more time to file a proposed procedural schedule.

The motion indicates that discussions among the parties have been fruitful and that the parties anticipate reaching an agreement that will resolve their dispute. If the dispute cannot be resolved, the parties will file a proposed procedural schedule by November 1. The motion represents that no party opposes the requested extension of time.

The motion for extension of time is reasonable and is not opposed by any party. It will be granted.

**IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:**

1. That CenturyTel of Missouri, LLC and Spectra Communications Group, LLC, d/b/a CenturyTel's Motion to Extend Filing of Proposed Procedural Schedule is granted.

2. That the parties shall file a proposed procedural schedule by November 1, 2005, if the case is not otherwise resolved before that date.

3. That this order shall become effective on October 19, 2005.
