ORDER GRANTING MOTION FOR EXTENSION TO FILE TARIFF

Issue Date: April 30, 2012 Effective Date: April 30, 2012

On April 4, 2012, the Commission issued an order establishing procedures for consideration of access rate tariffs expected to be filed by a large number of local exchange telecommunications carriers. That order directed the companies to file such tariffs 60 days before the effective date of the proposed tariff. Since the FCC has mandated that the anticipated tariff revisions be effective by July 1, such tariff revisions will need to be filed by May 1. On April 20, Southwestern Bell Telephone Company, d/b/a AT&T Missouri, filed a motion asking the Commission to allow it an additional fifteen days to file its tariff.

AT&T Missouri's request is reasonable and the Commission will grant that motion.

THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:

- 1. Southwestern Bell Telephone Company, d/b/a AT&T Missouri's Motion for Extension of Time is granted.
- 2. Southwestern Bell Telephone Company, d/b/a AT&T Missouri is allowed until May 15, 2012 to file tariff revisions to implement transitional intrastate access service rate changes required by the FCC.

3. This order shall become effective immediately upon issuance.
