ORDER DIRECTING FILING

On October 22, 2020, the Missouri-American Water Company (MAWC or Company) filed its Application and Motion for Waiver (Application). The Company applied for a Certificate of Convenience and Necessity (CCN) authorizing it to install, own, acquire, construct, operate, control, manage, and maintain a water system in an area of Stone County, Missouri (Table Rock Estate Subdivision). The Commission Staff filed its Recommendation on February 4, 2021, recommending approval of the Application with conditions.

Staff's Recommendation stated MAWC had supplied a map for the proposed service area which had boundary lines drawn through some lots and houses. The Recommendation stated that Staff and MAWC had researched the boundary lines and had agreed upon a more accurate service area map. Staff recommended approval of the CCN with the condition that MAWC submit tariff sheets that will cancel service area maps and descriptions and rate sheets applicable to customers in the Table Rock area; and with the condition that MAWC submit tariff sheets, to become effective before closing on the assets, to include a service area map and service area written description to be

included in its EFIS water tariff P.S.C. MO No. 13. Because the Application is for a CCN for service in a specific territory, the Commission will order the parties to now file a service area map and legal description for the area for which a CCN is sought.

THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:

1. No later than February 15, 2021, the Commission Staff and MAWC shall consult and either file a map and legal description for the territory for the area for which MAWC seeks a CCN; or file a pleading suggesting a deadline for the filing of those documents.

2. This order shall be effective when issued.
