**RESPONSE TO ORDER DIRECTING APPLICANT
TO SUPPLEMENT APPLICATION**

COMES NOW Missouri-American Water Company (“MAWC” or “Company”), by and through the undersigned counsel, and, in response to the *Order Directing Applicant to Supplement Application*, states as follows to the Missouri Public Service Commission (“Commission”):

1. On December 29, 2021, the Commission issued its *Order Directing Applicant to Supplement Application*, wherein, among other things, it stated that “[i]n reviewing the documents filed in this matter, the Commission does not find any Flinn Engineering reports. The Commission will order that any and all versions of the report be filed.”

2. The Flinn Report utilized by the appraisers is found in Schedule BWL-2 of the Direct Testimony of Brian W. LaGrand (Item 18 in EFIS). An explanation of the origin of that document, a second copy of that report and a copy of the prior version, and a statement as to the existence of no other versions of the report is also found within Schedule BWL-3 of the Direct Testimony of Brian W. LaGrand (Item 18 in EFIS). Further, the Flinn Report used by the appraisers is also found as Schedule KES-1 to the Direct Testimony of Kelly Simpson (Item 23 in EFIS). Both testimonies have been provided under affidavit of the respective witness.
