## STAFF'S STATUS REPORT

**COMES NOW** the Staff of the Missouri Public Service Commission ("Staff"), through counsel, and filed *Staff's Status Report*, in response to the Commission's December 20, 2022 *Order Directing Filing of a Status Report*.

- 1. On June 29, 2022, in its *Amended Report and Order*, the Commission granted Missouri-American Water Company ("MAWC") Certificates of Convenience and Necessity to provide water and sewer service in the service areas formerly served by the City of Eureka, subject to 16 conditions set out in paragraph three of the order.
- 2. On December 20, 2022, the Commission directed Staff to file a report on the status of MAWC's compliance with these 16 conditions and to advise the Commission whether the file should be closed.
- 3. Staff states that MAWC has complied with these 16 conditions and recommends that the Commission close the file.
