ORDER DIRECTING STAFF TO INVESTIGATE AND SCHEDULING A SECOND PREHEARING CONFERENCE

The Commission conducted a prehearing conference on April 18, 2005. At that conference, the complainant, Rhonda Wesley, requested 90 days in which to conduct discovery. Kansas City Power & Light did not object to that request. The parties also agreed that an investigation and report by the Commission's Staff would be helpful.

Staff will be directed to investigate and file its report within 45 days. A second prehearing conference will be scheduled for July 20, at which time a procedural schedule will be established.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

1. That the Commission's Staff is directed to conduct a formal investigation of Rhonda Wesley's complaint against Kansas City Power & Light and to file a report concerning the results of that investigation by June 2, 2005.

2. That a second prehearing conference is scheduled for July 20, 2005, beginning at 10:00 a.m.

3. That this order shall become effective on April 18, 2005.
