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1 JUDGE STEARLEY: Morning. It is Tuesday, April 10th, 2012. The Commission set this time for a 2 3 procedural conference in File No. WA-2012-0018 which is captioned as, In the matter of Lincoln County 4 5 Sewer & Water, LLC for a certificate of convenience and necessity authorizing it to own, operate, 6 7 maintain, control, and manage water and sewer systems in Lincoln County, Missouri. 8

9 My name is Harold Stearley, and I'm the 10 presiding officer over today's conference. Let's 11 begin by taking entries of appearance starting with 12 Lincoln County.

13 MR. COOPER: Dean L. Cooper with the law 14 firm of Brydon, Swearengen & England, P.C., P.O. Box 456, Jefferson City, 65102, appearing on behalf 15 16 of Lincoln County Sewer & Water, LLC. 17 JUDGE STEARLEY: Thank you, Mr. Cooper. 18 And the Office of the Public Counsel. 19 MS. BAKER: Thank you. Christina Baker, 20 P.O. Box 2230, Jefferson City, Missouri 65102, appearing on behalf of the Office of the Public 21 22 Counsel and the rate payers. 23 JUDGE STEARLEY: Thank you. 24 And Staff of the Commission.

25 MS. LEWIS: Rachel Lewis and Amy Moore,

 behalf of the Staff of the Missouri Public Service

4 JUDGE STEARLEY: Okay. Thank you, 5 Ms. Lewis.

6 My understanding where we're at now 7 procedurally, Staff's filed its recommendations, but 8 we have objections and/or concerns from both Company 9 and Public Counsel. Have the parties been in any 10 further negotiations since the last round of filings 11 or talking to --

MR. COOPER: Since the last round? It's a timing question I think. Yeah, we've had some discussions, and at least from my perspective I think it would be worthwhile to have some more discussions.

JUDGE STEARLEY: Okay. Well, I guess at this point why don't you all file a status report with me a week from today on the 17th.

I neglected to bring my adjudication calendar down, and I don't know if you'll reach an impasse and think you need to have a hearing or not, but I didn't bring one down with me today. So I'm sorry, I don't have all of our schedules, but my calendar's filling up, so I have a lot of conflict dates. And I'm sure yours are all too since we're 1

stacking hearing on top of hearing.

I can give you my own conflict days for 2 3 the summer, but if you're still in negotiations and you think those will be productive, we may just hold 4 5 off on that until we get the status report. MR. COOPER: Yeah. I doubt we'd need 6 7 them today. MS. LEWIS: Yeah. I think it's probably 8 9 a better solution to put it off because between now and then you may get other conflicts as we may have. 10 So it'll be better to see what we're looking at 11 timewise. 12 13 JUDGE STEARLEY: All right. Any matters 14 need to be addressed today? 15 MS. LEWIS: We don't have any. 16 MR. COOPER: None for me. 17 JUDGE STEARLEY: All right.
