ORDER GRANTING MOTION TO DISMISS AND CLOSING DOCKET

On December 17, 1997, the Director of the Division of Manufactured Homes, Recreational Vehicles and Modular Units (Director) filed a Complaint against Charles W. Brune (Brune) alleging that Brune (1) operated as a dealer in manufactured homes without being registered as a dealer with the Commission in violation of Section 700.090, RSMo 1994, and Section 700.455, RSMo Supp. 1996; (2) failed to file the monthly sales reports required from a dealer in manufactured homes in violation of Section 700.460 and 4 CSR 240-120.130; and (3) failed to comply with setup procedures for a manufactured home in violation of Section 700.100.3(6). On April 14, the parties filed a Stipulation and Agreement with the Commission, and on April 30 the Commission issued an order approving the Stipulation and Agreement.

All statutory references are to the Revised Statutes of Missouri, 1994, unless otherwise indicated.

Pursuant to paragraphs 7 and 19 of the Stipulation and Agreement the Director agreed to file a Notice of Dismissal with Prejudice when Brune has completed the specified repair and replacement items. Director filed its Motion for Dismissal with Prejudice on August 25. Director requested that the application be dismissed with prejudice to refiling because Brune has completed all the repair and replacement items to the satisfaction of the Director.

The Commission has reviewed Director's motion and finds that the motion is reasonable and should be granted. This case shall be dismissed and the docket closed.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

- 1. That the motion of The Director of the Division of Manufactured Homes, Recreational Vehicles and Modular Units to dismiss this case with prejudice is granted.
 - 2. That this case is dismissed with prejudice to refiling.
 - 3. That this docket is closed.
- 4. That this order shall become effective on September 23, 1997.
