



Pursuant to paragraphs 7 and 19 of the Stipulation and Agreement the Director agreed to file a Notice of Dismissal with Prejudice when Brune has completed the specified repair and replacement items. Director filed its Motion for Dismissal with Prejudice on August 25. Director requested that the application be dismissed with prejudice to refiling because Brune has completed all the repair and replacement items to the satisfaction of the Director.

The Commission has reviewed Director's motion and finds that the motion is reasonable and should be granted. This case shall be dismissed and the docket closed.

**IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:**

1. That the motion of The Director of the Division of Manufactured Homes, Recreational Vehicles and Modular Units to dismiss this case with prejudice is granted.
2. That this case is dismissed with prejudice to refiling.
3. That this docket is closed.
4. That this order shall become effective on September 23, 1997.
