ORDER CANCELING CERTIFICATE AND TARIFF

The Commission received a written request from Maura O'Toole of Voyager Networks, Inc., a competitive telecommunications company, on March 18, 1997, requesting that the company be de-tariffed in Missouri. In its Memorandum filed on June 27, the Staff of the Commission (Staff) stated it had contacted the company, and confirmed the request to cancel the company's certificate of service authority granted in Case No. TA-96-118 and accompanying tariffs. Staff recommended that the Commission issue an order to cancel the certificate of service authority and accompanying tariff.


Based upon the company's written request and Staff's recommendation, the Commission will cancel the certificate of service authority and accompanying tariff. The request indicates that the company has no customers in Missouri.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

1. That the certificate of service authority to provide interexchange telecommunications services within the State of Missouri and the accompanying tariff of Voyager Networks, Inc. are hereby canceled. ..
