## ORDER DENYING PETITION

The Office of the Public Counsel ("Public Counsel") filed a Petition For Promulgation Of Rules Relating To Disconnection Of Local Service For Nonpayment Of Toll And Other Charges ("Petition") on August 22, 1997. The Petition proposes an amendment to 4 CSR 240-33.070(2). The Commission has reviewed the Petition and made the following findings of fact and conclusions of law.

## **Findings of Fact**

- 1. Public Counsel's Petition does not comply with rule 4 CSR 240-2.180 in the following respects:
- a. The Petition does not contain the street address of the petitioner, as required by 4 CSR 240-2.180(3)(A)2.A.;
- b. The Petition does not contain the full text of the rule sought to be amended, as required by 4 CSR 240-2.180(3)(A)2.C.;
- c. The Petition does not contain a statement of the petitioner's reasons in support of subsection (2)(f) of the proposed rule, as required by 4 CSR 240-2.180(3)(A)3.;

Commission further concludes that some or all of the provisions proposed by Public Counsel may be acceptable to the Commission and should be considered by Staff in preparing revisions to 4 CSR 240-33. The Commission further concludes that a combined rulemaking effort would be more efficient than separate rulemaking efforts, and that a combined rulemaking effort would assist the Commission with considering a rule proposed by Public Counsel in connection with other proposed revisions. Public Counsel's Petition should therefore be denied.

## IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

- 1. That the Office of the Public Counsel's "Petition For Promulgation Of Rules Relating To Disconnection Of Local Service For Nonpayment Of Toll And Other Charges" is hereby denied.
- 2. That the Staff of the Public Service Commission shall consider the rule amendments proposed by Public Counsel in preparing revisions to 4 CSR 240-33.
  - 3. That this order shall become effective on September 26, 1997.
