ORDER GRANTING MOTION TO FILE SECOND AMENDED COMPLAINT

On October 5, 1994, an amended complaint was filed by Tesson Heights Enterprises (Complainant). On November 4, the Commission issued its order setting this matter for an early prehearing conference, subsequently held on December 19, 1994. On January 4, 1995, the Complainant filed a motion for leave to file a second amended complaint and a second amended complaint. Complainant states that the second amended complaint is for the purpose of adding specificity to its original amended complaint.

As a basis for its motion, the Complainant cites Commission rule 4 CSR 240-2.080(3), which provides that such amendments may be offered at any time before submission of the case to the Commission for decision.

As this case has not yet been submitted to the Commission, and as no other party has objected to the Complainant's motion, the Commission finds that the proposed amendment causes no prejudice to any party to this litigation, and will grant the Complainant's motion.

The Commission will accept the proposed amended complaint.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

1. That the motion by Tesson Heights Enterprises to amend its complaint in this case is hereby granted and the amended complaint is accepted for filing.

2. That this order shall become effective on the date hereof.
