## ORDER GRANTING INTERVENTION AND SETTING PREHEARING CONFERENCE

On December 15, 1994, Kansas City Power & Light Company (KCPL) filed an application with the Commission requesting permission to sell sulfur dioxide emission allowances. On December 20, 1994, the Commission gave notice of the application and set an intervention date. The City of Kansas City, Missouri (Kansas City) and Union Electric Company (UE) filed applications to intervene. UE states that its interest in the case is to the extent that a decision would set a precedent for how sales of allowances are handled. UE states further that it has no interest in causing the matter to be set for hearing.

The Commission will grant the interventions pursuant to 4 CSR 240-2.110(14). Kansas City is a municipality and is authorized to intervene on that basis, and UE has an interest different from that of the general public since it is an owner of sulfur dioxide emission allowances.

The Commission also finds that a prehearing conference should be set in this matter for February 21, 1995, so the parties can discuss a proposed procedural schedule and substantive issues regarding the application. The prehearing conference will be convened as established in the ordered paragraphs below.

## IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

- 1. That the City of Kansas City, Missouri, and Union Electric Company are hereby granted intervention in this case.
- 2. That a prehearing conference is hereby set for February 21, 1995, at 10:00 a.m. in the Commission's offices on the fifth floor of the Harry S Truman State Office Building, 301 West High Street, Jefferson City, Missouri.
- 3. That the parties shall file a proposed procedural schedule or pleading indicating the proposed disposition of this case on or before February 24, 1995.
  - 4. That this order shall become effective on the date hereof.
