NOTICE OF VOLUNTARY DISMISSAL
AND NOTICE CLOSING CASE

Issue Date: July 25, 2006

On July 20, 2006, Vandora R. Henry filed a Withdrawal of Complaint voluntarily dismissing her complaint against Kansas City Power & Light Company. Ms. Henry states that she and KCPL have reached a mutually agreeable resolution of the matters raised in her complaint.

On July 21, 2006, Ms. Henry and Missouri Gas Energy filed a Notice of Voluntary Dismissal. The motion states that after negotiation, Ms. Henry and MGE have agreed to a satisfactory resolution of her complaint.

Commission rule 4 CSR 240-2.116(1) states that a complaint may be voluntarily dismissed "at any time before prepared testimony has been filed or oral evidence has been offered" Prepared testimony has not been filed and oral evidence has not been offered.
