## ORDER APPROVING TARIFF SHEET

On October 19, 1994, Sprint Communications Company, L.P. (Sprint) filed a tariff sheet designed to introduce "Business Sense Introductory" and Business Sense Longevity" services. Sprint requested expedited treatment of the tariff sheet.

"Business Sense Introductory" will offer new "Business Sense" customers one free month total usage. The one free month of usage would be given as a credit on the monthly bill. The credit would be based on and applied in the fifth full billing month. The credit would be capped at 150 percent of the customer's minimum monthly commitment and should a customer disconnect prior to the fifth month the credit would not apply. "Business Sense Longevity" will offer new "Business Sense" customers two free months total usage. The two free months of usage would be given as a credit on the monthly bill. The credit would be based on and applied in the tenth and fifteenth full billing months. Each credit would be capped at 150 percent of the customer's minimum monthly commitment and should a customer disconnect prior to the tenth or fifteenth month the credit would not apply. Both promotions would be available through November 30, 1994 and service must be activated by December 31, 1994.

On November 3, 1994, the Staff of the Commission (Staff) filed a memorandum recommending that the Commission approve Sprint's proposed tariff sheet. Staff stated that it had no objections to the proposed tariff sheet or to its approval on an expedited basis.

Upon review of the proposed tariff sheet and Staff's recommendation, the Commission finds that Sprint's proposal is reasonable. Thus, the Commission determines that the tariff sheet filed by Sprint on October 19, 1994 should be approved for service on and after November 9, 1994.

## IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

1. That the following tariff sheet filed by Sprint Communications Company, L.P. is hereby approved for service on and after November 9, 1994:

1st Revised Sheet No. 86 Canceling Original Sheet No. 86.

2. That this Order shall become effective on November 9, 1994.
