ORDER GRANTING MOTION

The Commission issued its order in this matter on July 8, 1994, directing Union Electric Company (UE), as part of its required integrated resource filing, to file specimen tariff sheets for its pilot and full-scale demand-side programs which constitute promotional practices under the Commission's rules. On August 16, 1994, UE filed a motion requesting an extension of time to October 1, 1994 to complete this filing.

In its motion, UE states that it has contacted the other parties to this matter and none have any objection to this extension. As its reason for this extension, UE simply states that it is unable to complete the necessary plan and obtain management approval by September 1, 1994.

The Commission has considered this motion and would point out to UE that the September 1, 1994 deadline was suggested by UE itself. However, as no other party has objected to this extension, the Commission will extend the date set out in its order of July 8, 1994 to no later than October 1, 1994. No further extensions will be granted.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

1. That the deadline for specimen tariff filings as detailed above, set in the Commission's order of July 8, 1994 as being September 1, 1994, is hereby extended to no later than 3:00 p.m. on October 1, 1994.
