**ORDER GRANTING CONTINUANCE**

On April 17, 1996, intervenor Williams Natural Gas Company (WNG) filed a motion to extend the date, set by the Commission in its order of March 5, 1996, for the filing of motions to strike testimony. Currently that deadline is set on April 18, 1996. WNG seeks to move the Commission to extend that deadline to April 22, 1996.

WNG states that, on April 15, 1996, it received surrebuttal testimony from intervenor Mid-Kansas Partnership and Riverside Pipeline Company, L.P., containing a significant amount of material that WNG would like to review in depth to ascertain if the testimony should be subject to a motion to strike.


The Commission finds the WNG motion to be reasonable and not prejudicial to any other party. The Commission will grant the WNG motion and order the deadline extended through April 22, 1996.

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**IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:**

1. That the motion to extend the deadline for the filing of motions to strike testimony is hereby granted and the deadline is amended to extend through the close of business, April 26, 1996, in order to allow all parties sufficient time.
2. That this order shall become effective on the date hereof.
