## **ORDER DIRECTING STAFF TO INVESTIGATE AND FILE A REPORT**

On September 19, 2006, Richard D. Smith filed a complaint with the Commission against Union Electric Company d/b/a AmerenUE ("AmerenUE").<sup>1</sup> Notice of the complaint was issued to AmerenUE on September 20, and AmerenUE filed its answer to the complaint on October 20.

The Commission would like to have the benefit of an investigation and report by its Staff before it further considers this complaint.

Because Black River has an interest in this matter that could potentially be affected by the Commission's decision, it was added as a party to this action.

1. The Commission's Staff is directed to conduct a formal investigation of Richard D. Smith's complaint against Union Electric Company d/b/a AmerenUE and to file a report concerning the results of that investigation no later than November 20, 2006.
