ORDER GRANTING MOTION TO CONSOLIDATE

On February 12, 2019, Elm Hills Utility Operating Company, Inc. ("Elm Hills") filed applications with the Missouri Public Service Commission requesting that the Commission grant it Certificates of Convenience and Necessity to acquire, own, install, construct, operate, control, manage and maintain both a water system and sewer system (see SA-2019-0236) in Pettis County, Missouri, in an area known as Stone Creek near the city of Sedalia. On March 7, in both cases, Elm Hills filed a *Motion to Consolidate* in the interests of administrative efficiency and the economy of resources. No objections were received.

Commission Rule 4 CSR 240-2.110(3) allows for the consolidation of cases with related questions of law or fact. Since these cases involve related questions of law and fact, the Commission will grant the motion.

THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:

1. Elm Hills Utility Operating Company, Inc.'s *Motion to Consolidate* File Nos. WA-2019-0235 and SA-2019-0236 is granted, with File No. WA-2019-0235 being the lead case.

2. This order shall be effective when issued.
