#### ORDER OF RULEMAKING

By the authority vested in the Missouri Public Service Commission under section 386.410, RSMo 2000, the commission amends a rule as follows:

#### 4 CSR 240-2.140 is amended.

A notice of proposed rulemaking containing the text of the proposed amendments was published in the *Missouri Register* on April 15, 2011 (36 MoReg 1062). Those sections with changes are reprinted here. These proposed amendments become effective thirty (30) days after publication in the *Code of State Regulations*.

SUMMARY OF COMMENTS: A public hearing on the proposed amendments was held May 19, 2011, and the public comment period ended May 16, 2011. One (1) written comment was received and no one testified at the public hearing.

COMMENT: Lewis Mills, on behalf of the Office of the Public Counsel, filed a written comment that the word "initial" had been in advertently deleted from section (2).

RESPONSE AND EXPLANATION OF CHANGE: The commission will correct the error by inserting "initial" before "post-hearing" in section (2).

#### 4 CSR 240-2.140 Briefs and Oral Arguments

(2) Unless otherwise ordered by the commission or presiding officer, initial post-hearing briefs shall be filed no later than twenty (20) days after the date on which the complete transcript of the hearing is filed.
