ORDER DENYING MOTION TO QUASH

On April 24, 2020, Confluence Rivers Utility Operating Company, Inc. (Confluence Rivers) filed a motion to quash the non-disclosure agreements (NDAs) of two persons filed on behalf of the Lake Perry Lot Owners Association (Lot Owners). NDAs are addressed in Commission Rule 20 CSR 4240-2.135, subsections six and seven.

Confluence Rivers objected that the expertise of the two persons as applied to this case is not apparent. Confluence Rivers also argued that the NDA signatories must have expertise in the subject matter of an upcoming evidentiary hearing, and cannot be experts in other matters of the case. Confluence Rivers then implies two conditions from the Commission rule: 1) the experts must have true expertise regarding the issues or subjects

for which the access is sought; and 2) the information sought must be within the area of expertise.

Neither subsection six nor seven of 20 CSR 4240-2.135 requires that the reason for the retention of the expert must be made known before an NDA is filed. Nor do those subsections require that the expertise of an NDA signatory be limited in the manner suggested by Confluence Rivers. The Commission also declines to find the two conditions are implied from the rule as suggested by Confluence Rivers.

THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:

- 1. The motion to quash filed by Confluence Rivers on April 24, 2020, is denied.
- 2. This order shall be effective when issued.
