ORDER SETTING EVIDENTIARY HEARING

On March 17, 2020, the Staff of the Commission (Staff) filed a *Joint Proposed Procedural Schedule*. Confluence Rivers Utility Company responded. The Commission adopted the proposed schedule while stating that the evidentiary hearing would be ordered separately.

Staff and the Office of the Public Counsel recommended an evidentiary hearing date of May 21-22, 2020. Confluence Rivers did not object to the date of the hearing. Due to the scheduling needs of Commission, the evidentiary hearing will be held earlier in the suggested week.

THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:

1. The Commission shall hold an evidentiary hearing on May 19-20, 2020, at 10:00 a.m.
2. Participants shall appear at the evidentiary hearing telephonically via WebEx conference call. As the hearing will be live-streamed, the Commission requests interested persons who will not be actively participating in the hearing to watch or listen via the live-stream. The link and access code to participate in the hearing via WebEx conference call will be emailed to all parties.
