ORDER CANCELING CERTIFICATE OF CONVENIENCE AND NECESSITY AND TARIFF AND ORDER CLOSING CASE

Issue Date: February 6, 2007

Effective Date: February 16, 2007

On June 5, 2006, Frimel Water System, Inc. ("Frimel") and Lake Lorraine Property Owners' Association ("Association") (collectively "Joint Applicants") filed a Joint Petition seeking authority for Frimel to transfer its assets to the Association. On November 7, the Commission issued its order approving the transfer with conditions. The Commission also directed the Joint Applicants to notify the Commission when the transaction was completed, upon which the Frimel would be relieved of its obligation to provide water and sewer service to the public in its assigned service area and the Commission would cancel its certificate and tariff.

On December 11, 2006, the Association filed a status report indicating that all that remained to finalize this transaction was for the Department of Revenue to issue a Tax Clearance letter for Frimel, and for the Secretary of State to issue a Certificate of Termination dissolving Frimel as a corporate entity. On February 5, 2007, the Association filed a letter and final report notifying the Commission that the letter and certificate were

issued. The Association included copies of the required documents with its final report. The Commission will therefore cancel the Frimel's certificate and tariff, and close this case.

IT IS ORDERED THAT:

1. The Certificate of Convenience and Necessity of Frimel Water System, Inc., issued in Case No. 15,398, shall be canceled.
2. Frimel Water System, Inc.'s tariff shall be canceled.
3. This order shall become effective on February 16, 2007.
4. This case may be closed on February 17, 2007.
