I also feel that somebody wasn't doing their part, as far as 2 meters reading wrong or not registering I was home and present on the day they changed a meter. The only thing the tech. said was they had to change it out. I figured they were updating them. I would think that a new meter would be monitored just to see if it was working and registering properly. They wait for a whole year and send a bill for \$1300⁰⁰ + with paper work. Then I filed a complaint (informal)

3. The Complainant has taken the following steps to present this complaint to the Respondent:

And the paper work I received from the Commission board (from KPL) doesn't match up with the paperwork that KPL sent me with the orig. bill. Why doesn't the paper work and dates don't match? KPL sent the same documents to me + the Commission board. They're diff. Also they said they were going back 1 yr. to charge me for, those amounts don't even match the amount on the bill either.

WHEREFORE, Complainant now requests the following relief:

to be ~~relieved~~ relieved of (the year) they're trying to charge me for. Also up to the month it got corrected. I just don't think it's fair to charge for KPL's mistake.
