## ORDER SETTING PREHEARING CONFERENCE

On March 23, 2011, Tucker Shell, LLC filed an amended complaint against Union Electric Company, d/b/a Ameren Missouri. Ameren filed an answer to the complaint and requests that Tucker's complaint be dismissed for failure to state a claim for which relief can be granted.

This matter is now at issue and a prehearing conference and procedural schedule are appropriate to ensure a prompt resolution. At the prehearing conference, the parties or their representatives should be prepared to discuss the nature of any discovery each will conduct and the interval necessary for its completion; the number of witnesses each expects to call at hearing; the number and nature of any exhibits each expects to offer at hearing; and the anticipated length of the hearing. The parties or their representatives should also be prepared to discuss the current status of settlement negotiations. It is expected that the prehearing conference will provide an opportunity for the parties to further pursue settlement discussions.
