ORDER DIRECTING NOTICE, SETTING INTERVENTION DEADLINE, AND MAKING TIME WARNER CABLE A PARTY

Issue Date: November 3, 2021

Effective Date: November 3, 2021

This order provides notice of this application to interested parties, establishes a deadline for intervention and for requesting a hearing, and joins the other party to the Interconnection Agreement, Time Warner Cable Information Services (Missouri), LLC d/b/a Time Warner Cable as a party to this proceeding.

On October 12, 2021, CenturyTel of Missouri, LLC d/b/a CenturyLink and Spectra Communications Group, LLC d/b/a CenturyLink, filed an application with the Commission for approval of a negotiated Interconnection Agreement with Time Warner Cable under the provisions of the Federal Telecommunications Act of 1996. CenturyLink states that there are no unresolved issues and that the Agreement complies with Section 252(e) of the Act in that it is consistent with the public interest, convenient and necessary, and is not discriminatory to nonparty carriers. That initial application was deficient in that it did not comply with the 60-day notice requirements of Commission Rule 20 CSR 4240-4.017. After

the Commission issued notice of that deficiency, CenturyLink filed an amended application on October 28, 2021.

Although Time Warner Cable is a party to the Agreement, it did not join in the application. Because Time Warner Cable is a necessary party to a full and fair adjudication of this matter, the Commission will add Time Warner Cable as a party to this case.

The Act provides that an Interconnection or Resale Agreement must be approved unless the state commission finds that the Agreement discriminates against a telecommunications carrier not a party to the Agreement, or that implementation of the Agreement is not consistent with the public interest, convenience, and necessity.¹ Section 252(e)(4) of the Act provides that if the Commission has not approved an Agreement within 90 days after submission, the Agreement shall be deemed approved. The Commission finds that proper persons shall be allowed 15 days from the issuance of this order to file a motion for hearing. The Commission also finds that notice of this application shall be sent to all interexchange and local exchange telecommunications companies.

THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:

1. The Commission's Data Center shall send notice to all interexchange and local exchange telecommunications companies.
2. Time Warner Cable is made a party to this case.
3. Any party wishing to intervene or request a hearing shall do so by filing a pleading no later than November 18, 2021, with:

4. The Staff of the Commission shall file a recommendation advising either approval or rejection of this Agreement and giving the reasons therefor no later than December 3, 2021.

5. This order shall be effective when issued.
