**Re: Notice of Change in Corporate Form and Name Change for Wisper
ISP, Inc.**

Dear Mr. Woodruff:

Pursuant to 20 CSR 4240.28.011 and 20 CSR 4240-31.015, Wisper ISP, Inc. (“Wisper”), by its attorneys, hereby respectfully notifies the Missouri Public Service Commission (“Commission”) of its change in name to Wisper ISP, LLC. Wisper currently holds authority to provide telecommunications services and interconnected Voice over Internet Protocol (“VoIP”) services pursuant to Docket Nos. CN-2019-0205 and DN-2019-0194. Wisper also was designated as an eligible telecommunications carrier (“ETC”) in Docket No. CA-2019-0196.

Effective July 7, 2020, Wisper converted from an Illinois corporation to a Delaware limited liability company, and now operates under the name Wisper ISP, LLC. Accompanying this letter is documentation from the State of Delaware reflecting the name change.

Also on July 7, 2020, Wisper filed its Application for Registration of a Foreign Limited Liability Company with the Missouri Secretary of State. Accompanying this letter is the Application for Registration. The State of Missouri’s online database has not yet been updated to reflect Wisper’s filing, and Wisper will file any additional required Missouri documentation as soon as it becomes available.

In accordance with 20 CSR 4240.28.011 pertaining to change in name for a certificate or registration, Wisper states that it has reviewed and updated its company contacts in EFIS and will submit a notice advising the Commission of the same in this proceeding, once a docket number has been established.

Further, Wisper further notes that in Docket No. CN-2019-0205, in which Wisper gained control of the assets of Aurora Communications, including its license to provide basic local telecommunications services granted by the Commission in File No. CA-2007-0175 and its IVoIP registration, Wisper adopted Aurora's tariff then in effect. Wisper will file a similar notice of its adoption of tariff under the new name of Wisper ISP, LLC once a docket number has been established for this proceeding.

In accordance with 20 CSR 4240-31.015, pertaining to change in name for an ETC, Wisper reaffirms its statements above regarding registration of the new name with the Missouri Secretary of State. Wisper further submits that it will continue to comply with all applicable laws and rules regarding to ETC designation. Wisper states that it has reviewed and updated its company contacts in EFIS and will submit a notice advising the Commission of the same in this proceeding, once a docket number has been established.

Wisper is still in the buildout process to its ETC areas in Missouri, and thus has no current ETC customers that will require notice of the name change.
