**WITHDRAWAL OF MOTION FOR PROTECTIVE ORDER
OF INFINITY WIND POWER**

Infinity Wind Power (Infinity) hereby withdraws its Motion for Protective Order filed in this proceeding on November 7, 2016 (Motion). Infinity sought protection against the disclosure of certain sensitive, competitive pricing and contract information subject to the discovery requests issued to the Missouri Joint Municipal Electric Utility Commission (MJMEUC) by the Missouri Landowners Alliance (MLA) on October 26, 2016. Specifically, Infinity sought protection against disclosure of information in response to MLA data requests MJM.10, MJM.12, and to the extent applicable, MJM.3.¹ Since the filing of the Motion, counsel for Infinity, MJMEUC, and MLA have reached a mutual consensus with regard to Infinity specific data sought as part of the referenced data requests, and as such the need for a protective order is no longer necessary at this time.

WHEREFORE, Infinity Wind Power respectfully withdraws its motion for protective order filed on November 7, 2016.
