AMENDMENTS TO CONSTITUTION & BY-LAWS OF LAKE LORRAINE PROPERTY OWNERS' ASSOCIATION

The following Amendments were adopted by more than two-thirds of the lot owners of Lake Lorraine Subdivision, at the regular meeting of October 22, 2006, which same Amendments are adopted by virtue of Article VI - Amendments of the Constitution and By-Laws of Lake Lorraine Property Owners' Association:

CONSTITUTION

Article III - Officers

This Article of the Constitution and By-Laws is amended to provide for a separate office of Vice President, from the separate office of Treasurer. References to the Vice President having Treasurer duties are deleted.

Article IV - Membership

Members of Lake Lorraine Property Owners' Association shall be property owners in Lake Lorraine Subdivision (whose current assessments are paid in full) or be customers of Frimel Water System, Inc. (or its successors). Members by virtue of their status as customers of the water system, who are property owners within Lake Lorraine Subdivision and do not have their assessments paid in full, shall only participate in water system decisions and shall not have a vote on subdivision issues.

BY-LAWS

Article I - Members

Members in the Association shall include customers of Frimel Water System, Inc. (or its successors), but only to the extent of participation and voting on issues pertaining to the water system, or its related charges.

Article II - Dues

Original Article II - Dues is deleted in its entirety.

Article III - Directors and Election of Officers

Paragraph 1 of Article III is deleted in its entirety and in its place the following Paragraph 1 is inserted:

1. The Directors shall consist of the President, Vice President, Secretary, Treasurer and three members of the Executive Board.

Article IV - Officers

This Article of the Constitution and By-Laws is amended to provide for a separate office of Vice President, from the separate office of Treasurer. References to the Vice President having Treasurer duties are deleted.

The Treasurer shall have the following duties:

The Treasurer shall have full custody of all funds of the Association and shall keep full and accurate account of all receipts and disbursements.

The Treasurer shall provide a statement of accounts at each regular meeting and as called upon, at special meetings.

The Treasurer shall deposit all monies in the name and to the credit of the Association in such depository as may be directed by the Board of Directors.

The Treasurer's books shall be audited at the close of each year by a person or Certified Public Accountant, as authorized by the Board of Directors.

The Board of Directors may, by majority vote, inspect the Treasurer's records at any time.

Article VI - Salaries

Article VI is deleted in its entirety and in its place is substituted the following Article VI:

No salaries or other compensation shall be paid or allowed the Officers or Directors of the Association.

Article VIII - Water System

A new Article VIII to the By-Laws shall read as follows:

Article VIII - Water System. The Association shall operate the water supply system which presently serves the Lake and surrounding property owners as a not-for-profit operation. All customers of the water system shall be entitled to participate in any votes concerning the expenditure of water system revenue or the charge which is made to customers of the water system. No

lot owner of Lake Lorraine Subdivision who is not a customer of the water system shall participate in water system decisions, expenditures or charges.

All customers of the water system shall have a reasonable right of inspection of the financial records relating to the water system and the charges therefor.

MINUTES OF GENERAL MEETING OF LAKE LORRAINE PROPERTY OWNERS ASSOCIATION (LLPOA)

The General Meeting of the LAKE LORRAINE PROPERTY OWNERS ASSOCIATION (LLPOA) was held on October 22, 2006, at 1:00 p.m., Jefferson College, Hillsboro, Missouri. Officers and Board Members Present: David Wojtkowski, Carl Keener, Robert Markham, Billie Norman, Marlyn Edmonds, and Trustee, Susan Wojtkowski. Absent: Paul Berndt and Michael Noakes. See attached for members/visitors in attendance.

Carl Keener explained the process involved to change the management and ownership of Frimel Water System Inc. to the LLPOA. Carl received DS1 certification and will handle the duties of water systems operator. Wojtkowski was retained as trustee to perform accounting and bookkeeping; meters should be read and payments made monthly. Doyle Kirchner was retained as meter contractor. Bob Markham explained the electric upgrade scheduled for the well house. DNR Primacy Fee increased as of 09/01/06, and increase will be added to the rate when new meter cards are issued-no increase in the rate for water planned.

David Wojtkowski read the proposed Amendments to the LLPOA Constitution and By-Laws as drafted by Attorney Ray Dickhaner. After discussion, Motion made, seconded, and approved to accept proposed Amendments, 29 yes, 0 no. Property owner Dan Stodgell advised he is not a member of the LLPOA and requested this statement be entered into these minutes.

Robert Taylor, consultant and former owner of Strata, a drilling service company, presented slide presentation and explained 1955 installation of dam, repairs which his company made in 1981, and the repairs needed now to seal the seam in the bedrock and stop the leak in the lake of approximately 300 gallons per minute. Over time, without repair, leak would continue to lower the lake level and although not currently a safety issue, could lead to a potential failure of the dam.

Bob Clay with Department of Natural Resources said the DNR would work with Strata and oversee any repairs. Dave Woj. advised special assessment would be needed to help pay the approximate cost of \$80,000 to repair leak; dam passed safety inspection by DNR this month, but DNR advised boats cannot be left in spillway and boats on the bank must be tied up.

Potholes in subdivision roads will be repaired as necessary, and bids will be sought for grading and/or paving of Scenic Knoll. Bid by Cole's Tree Service was accepted for snow removal during 2006-2007 winter season. Stan Lay will get bids for repair of subdivision entrance sign.

Grantorship: LLPOA is in the legal process of attaining grantorship from Solar-X of St. Louis and Transitions, Inc. LLPOA must be subdivision Grantor to pursue any special assessment or bank loan to cover large expenditures, i.e., lake repair or road upgrade/repaving.

Motion made, seconded and approved-Board will pursue alternate payment plans for repair of leak in the lake and upgrade and/or repaving of subdivision roads and present proposals at the January 2007 LLPOA General Meeting. Election: Nominated and by unanimous vote, the following were elected to serve as Officers and Board Members for the coming year: Dave Wojtkowski, President; Marlyn Edmonds, Vice President; Carl Keener, Treasurer; Daphne Jennewein, Secretary; Board Members-Bob Markham, Billie Norman, Mike Noakes. Meeting adjourned.
