On May 7, 2021, Missouri-American Water Company (MAWC) filed the above-referenced application. The application seeks, among other things, authority for MAWC to acquire and operate the assets of a municipal water and sewer system in Garden City, Missouri.

The Commission gave notice and received no intervention requests. Subsequently, MAWC amended its application, and stated that it neglected to address the issue of ratemaking rate base in its application. Staff responded, stating that it did not object to the amendment. But, Staff believes the amendment is significant enough to warrant additional notice and opportunity for intervention requests.

The Commission finds Staff's request reasonable, and will grant it.

The Commission will direct notice of the amended application be given to the county commission, local newspapers, and members of the General Assembly representing residents of Cass County, Missouri. The Commission will also direct notice of the amended application to the General Counsel for the Missouri Department of Natural Resources and will further set a deadline for interested parties to intervene.

THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:

1. The Commission's Data Center shall provide a copy of this order and the Amended Application to the County Commissions of Cass County, Missouri; to the media serving Cass County, Missouri, and to the General Counsel for the Missouri Department of Natural Resources;

2. Any person wishing to intervene in this matter shall file an application to intervene no later than June 23, 2021. The application shall be filed in the Commission's Electronic Filing and Information System ("EFIS") or with the Secretary of the Commission. Comments on the application can also be made in EFIS.

3. The Staff of the Commission shall file its Recommendation or alternative pleading no later than July 8, 2021.

4. This order shall be effective when issued.
