**ORDER EXTENDING TIME FOR RESPONSES TO OPC’s
MOTION FOR ADDITIONAL NOTICE LANGUAGE**

On February 25, 2022, Missouri-American Water Company (MAWC) filed an application (Application) requesting CCNs for a water and sewer system in an area of Pettis County, Missouri (Monsees Lake Estates Subdivision). The Staff of the Commission (Staff) has filed its recommendation of approval subject to certain conditions. MAWC has indicated its acceptance of Staff’s recommendation and conditions.

On June 28, 2022, the Office of the Public Counsel (OPC) filed a motion requesting that the Commission order an addition to the notice sent by MAWC to the Monsees Lake Estates Subdivision customers. Specifically, OPC requests MAWC be ordered to provide notice to customers that although MAWC intends to adopt Monsees’ current water and sewer rates, those rates may change based on MAWC’s current rate case, which has been noticed, but not yet filed, WR-2022-0303.

The Commission is concerned that this may create a situation in which customers have a defunct File Number should MAWC need to delay its rate case filing. Further, the phrasing “noticed but not filed” is a rather specific term of art used in practice before the

Commission and may not be easily understood by customers. The Commission suggests, but will not order, that OPC and MAWC (and Staff if it wishes) work together to develop notice language that is acceptable to all parties, if possible.

Due to the impending holiday and the Commission's suggestion, the normal 10-day response period under 20 CSR 4240-2.080(13) will be extended.

THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:

1. No party is required to respond, but any party that wishes to respond to OPC's request for additional notice language shall do so on or before July 12, 2022.
2. This order shall be effective when issued.
