## ORDER DIRECTING NOTICE AND SETTING DATES FOR SUBMISSION OF INTERVENTION REQUESTS AND STAFF RECOMMENDATION

On September 11, 2018, Missouri-American Water Company ("MAWC") filed an application with the Missouri Public Service Commission ("Commission") requesting that the Commission grant it a Certificate of Convenience and Necessity ("CCN") to install, own, acquire, construct, operate, control, manage and maintain a water system in Stone County, Missouri, within the city limits of Kimberling City. The requested CCN would allow MAWC to provide water service to an existing development known as the Golden Acres Subdivision. The Commission will direct that notice be given and set a deadline for intervention requests and Staff recommendation.

#### THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:

 The Commission's Data Center shall provide a copy of this order to the County Commission of Stone County, Missouri, the City Council of Kimberling City, and the Missouri Department of Natural Resources.

- 2. The Commission's Public Policy and Outreach Division shall make notice of this order available to the members of the General Assembly representing Stone County, Missouri and to the media serving Stone County, Missouri.
  - 3. Any application to intervene shall be filed no later than October 3, 2018.
- 4. The Commission's Staff shall file a recommendation regarding Missouri-American Water Company's application no later than November 12, 2018.
  - 5. This order shall be effective when issued.
