On April 26, 2021,<sup>2</sup> Missouri-American Water Company ("MAWC") filed applications requesting Certificates of Convenience and Necessity ("CCNs") to install, own, acquire, construct, operate, control, manage, and maintain a water system and sewer system in and around the City of Eureka, Missouri. On October 1, the Commission's Staff (Staff) filed its Recommendation and recommended the Commission either reject MAWC's applications, or, alternatively, impose specified conditions should the Commission approve the applications. The conference will be held virtually by WebEx.
