## ORDER GRANTING EXTENSION OF TIME

Issue Date: June 28, 2021 Effective Date: June 28, 2021

On April 26, 2021, Missouri-American Water Company (MAWC) filed applications to purchase and operate a water and sewer system in and around the City of Eureka, in St. Louis County, Missouri. The Commission directed a recommendation from the Staff of the Missouri Public Service Commission (Staff) no later than June 28, 2021. On that date Staff filed a request for an extension of time until September 27, 2021.

Staff's request for an extension was due to responses received in the initial rounds of data requests, which spurred Staff to investigate further. Moreover, Staff is awaiting certain historical information related to the operation of the City of Eureka systems. The historical information is held by the Missouri Department of Natural Resources, which has informed Staff not to expect a response before July 14, 2021.<sup>1</sup>

The Commission considers the request to be reasonable and will grant it.
