ORDER DIRECTING EMERALD POINTE UTILITY COMPANY TO **INDICATE WHEN IT WILL FILE IMPLEMENTING TARIFFS**

On December 2, 2004, the Commission granted Emerald Pointe Utility Company certificates of convenience and necessity to provide water and sewer service to an unincorporated area of Taney County, Missouri. That order directed Emerald Pointe to file appropriate tariffs to implement its service authority and provided that the certificates of convenience and necessity would not become effective until the Commission approved such tariffs.

Four months have now passed and Emerald Pointe has not yet filed implementing tariffs. The Commission will direct Emerald Pointe to file a report indicating when it will file such tariffs.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

1. That Emerald Pointe Utility Company shall, no later than April 15, file a report indicating when it intends to file the tariffs required to implement the certificates of convenience and necessity granted by the Commission in its order of December 2, 2004.

2. That this order shall become effective on April 1, 2005.
