On June 5, 2006, Frimel Water System, Inc. and Lake Lorraine Property Owners' Association filed a joint petition with the Missouri Public Service Commission seeking authority to transfer the assets of Frimel Water System, Inc. to Lake Lorraine Property Owners' Association and to cease Frimel's operations.

The Commission has determined that proper parties should be given notice and opportunity to intervene in this matter.
