## ORDER DIRECTING NOTICE AND FILING

The Missouri Public Service Commission (Commission) is giving notice of Highway H Utilities Inc.'s application to sell assets, setting a deadline for applications to intervene, and directing the Commission's Staff to file a recommendation.

Section 393.190.1, RSMo 2016, requires that the Commission must send notice "to the county clerk of each county in which any portion of a political subdivision which will be affected by such disposition is located." Since the application states that the water assets being sold are located in Pulaski County, Missouri, the Commission will direct its Data Center to send a copy of this order to the county clerk and county commission of Pulaski County, Missouri. The Commission will also establish deadlines for persons wishing to intervene and a preliminary response from its Staff.

**THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:**

1. The Commission's Data Center shall transmit this notice and order, with a copy of the application, to the county clerk and county commission of Pulaski County, Missouri.
2. The Commission's Public Policy and Outreach Department shall make notice of this order available to the members of the General Assembly representing the residents of Highway H Utilities, Inc.'s service area and to the news media serving those residents.
3. Any application to intervene shall be filed no later than November 9, 2017.
4. No later than November 9, 2017, the Staff of the Missouri Public Service Commission shall file a pleading stating when it anticipates filing its recommendation in this matter.
5. This order shall become effective immediately upon issuance.


