1 **Q. PLEASE STATE YOUR NAME AND BUSINESS ADDRESS.**

2 A. My name is Edward J. Haye and my business address is 1025 Laurel Oak Road,
3 Voorhees New Jersey, 08003.

4 **Q. BY WHOM ARE YOU EMPLOYED AND IN WHAT CAPACITY?**

5 A. I am employed by American Water Works Service Company, Inc. (“American
6 Water”) as Vice President, Chief Regulatory Counsel.

7 **Q. PLEASE DESCRIBE YOUR EDUCATIONAL BACKGROUND.**

8 A. I earned a Bachelor of Arts degree from Dartmouth College in 1983 and Juris
9 Doctor degree from Fordham University School of Law in 1990.

10 **Q. PLEASE DESCRIBE YOUR BUSINESS EXPERIENCE.**

11 A. From 1985 to 1990, I worked for Consolidated Edison Company of New York,
12 Inc., first as a paralegal in the Law Department, then as a Customer Relations
13 Analyst in the Customer Service Department, and finally as the Associate
14 Corporate Planner in the Office of the President. From 1990 to 1993, I was an
15 associate in the Energy and Utilities Department of LeBoeuf, Lamb, Greene &
16 MacRae representing domestic gas, electric, and water utilities in regulatory
17 proceedings before public utility commissions in various states. In 1993, I
18 accepted the position of Vice-President and General Counsel of Jamaica Water
19 Supply Company and Sea Cliff Water Company in New York. In 1995, I became
20 Executive Vice-President and General Counsel Jamaica Water Securities Corp.,
21 Jamaica Water Supply Company and Sea Cliff Water Company. In 1996, I was
22 promoted to President of Jamaica Water Supply Company. In 2005, I accepted a
23 position as Special Counsel at Saul Ewing LLP in the Business Department and
24 Energy & Utilities Practice Group. In 2010, I joined American Water as
25 Regulatory Counsel. In 2014, I was promoted to Chief Regulatory Counsel, and in
26 2016, Vice President, Chief Regulatory Counsel for American Water.

27 **Q. WHAT ARE YOUR DUTIES AS VICE PRESIDENT, CHIEF
28 REGULATORY COUNSEL?**

1 A. I advise and support the development of Company-wide regulatory strategies. I
2 also work with rate leaders and in-house counsel to support and implement the
