STATUS REPORT AS TO FAWN LAKE

COMES NOW Confluence Rivers Utility Operating Company, Inc., (“Confluence Rivers” or “Company”) and for its *Status Report As Fawn Lake* respectfully states as follows to the Missouri Public Service Commission (“Commission”):

1. On December 9, 2020 (effective January 8, 2021), the Commission issued its *Order Approving Acquisition of Water and Sewer Assets and Granting Certificates of Convenience and Necessity* (“Order”) in this case. The *Order* set forth a schedule for filing status reports to apprise the Commission of the status of closing on each utility system’s assets.
2. Confluence Rivers states that the closing on the utility system assets of Fawn Lake Water Corp. (“Fawn Lake”) has yet to occur. Fawn Lake continues to work with the homeowner’s association for the release of all liens on the utility system assets.
3. Confluence Rivers is unsure when closing will take place.

WHEREFORE, Confluence Rivers respectfully submits this *Status Report As Fawn*

Lake to the Commission.
