3. This pleading is meant to apprise the Commission of the status of the Company's sale of its assets to the City of Lexington.

4. Staff has received verbal notice from the Company that the sale has not yet closed, and is projected to close in late February, or March, due to completion of certain projects, and certain sale details yet to be resolved.
