## ORDER ACKNOWLEDGING VOLUNTARY DISMISSAL AND WITHDRAWING ORDER

Issue Date: January 29, 2013 Effective Date: January 29, 2013

The Missouri Public Service Commission is acknowledging the voluntary dismissal of this action and withdrawing the *Order Dismissing Application and Initiating Investigation*,<sup>1</sup> ("earlier order") which is not yet effective.

Old National Bank filed an application<sup>2</sup> seeking to transfer the assets of Tri-States Utility, Inc. to Old National Bank. The Commission dismissed the application for lack of subject matter jurisdiction, and directed the Staff to investigate the underlying issue and file a report, in the earlier order. The earlier order was originally effective on November 17, 2012, but the Commission granted the parties' requests to extend the earlier order's effective date<sup>3</sup> to January 31, 2013, pending their discussion of the dispute underlying this action.

On January 28, 2013, applicant Old National Bank filed *Old National Bank's Notice* of *Dismissal and Request for Withdrawal of Commission Order*. Old National Bank asks the Commission to withdraw the earlier order and voluntarily dismisses the application. The Commission's regulations allow voluntary dismissal any time before the introduction of evidence:

An applicant . . . may voluntarily dismiss an application . . . without an order of the commission at any time before prepared testimony has been filed or oral evidence has been offered by filing a notice of dismissal with the commission[.4]

Old National Bank represents that Tri-States Utility, Inc. supports the withdrawal of the earlier order, and that neither the Commission's staff nor the Office of the Public Counsel oppose the withdrawal of the earlier order. On those representations, the Commission will withdraw the earlier order and acknowledge Old National Bank's voluntary dismissal.

## THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:

- 1. Old National Bank's Notice of Dismissal and Request for Withdrawal of Commission Order is granted.
  - 2. The Order Dismissing Application and Initiating Investigation is withdrawn.
  - 3. This order shall become effective immediately upon issuance.
  - 4. This file shall close on January 30, 2013.
