On April 25, 2006, MCC Telephony of Missouri, Inc. filed an application with the Commission requesting a waiver of compliance with the requirements of 4 CSR 240-32.080(5)(A)1 related to time standards for installation of service. On April 28, 2006, the Office of the Public Counsel filed an objection to MCC Telephony's application contending, among other things, that MCC Telephony failed to state "good cause" for the requested waiver.

Before proceeding to consider this application, the Commission would like to have a recommendation from the Missouri Public Service Commission Staff. Therefore, the Commission will direct Staff to file a recommendation by May 26, 2006. If Staff finds that it is unable to offer its recommendation by that date, it may, of course, request additional time.
