**IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:**


1. That the City of Malden's request to withdraw its intervention is granted.

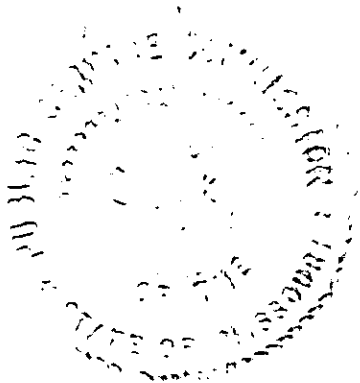
