ORDER CHANGING PROCEDURAL SCHEDULE

On December 15, 2005, Southwestern Bell Telephone, L.P., the Staff of the Missouri Public Service Commission, and the Office of the Public Counsel filed a Stipulation and Agreement. Southwestern Bell also filed a request that the procedural schedule in this matter be suspended pending disposition of the agreement. All the parties to the case concur with the request to suspend the procedural schedule.

The Commission has reviewed the motion for suspension of the procedural schedule and finds it to be reasonable. The Commission will suspend the remaining procedural schedule with the exception of the previously scheduled hearing date. The Commission will reserve the first day of the previously scheduled hearing for the presentation of the Stipulation by the parties and for the parties to respond to any questions that the Commission may have regarding the Stipulation.

The Commission notes that while the Stipulation and Agreement was not signed by all the parties, under the Commission's rules, a nonunanimous stipulation and agreement may be treated as a unanimous agreement if no party objects within seven days after the filing date.¹

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

1. That, with the exception of the first day of hearing, the procedural schedule is suspended until further order of the Commission.

2. That the parties shall appear on January 4, 2006, as previously ordered, to

present the Stipulation and Agreement and to answer any questions regarding the agreement.

3. That any nonsignatory party wishing to object to the agreement shall do so no later than December 22, 2005.

4. That this order shall become effective on December 16, 2005.
