12	Q. Please state your name and business address.
13	A. My name is Michael S. Scheperle. My business address is Post Office
14	Box 360, Governor Office Building, 200 Madison Street, Jefferson City, Missouri 65102-
15	0360.
16	Q. By whom are you employed?
17	A. I am employed by the Missouri Public Service Commission (Commission)
18	as an Economist II in the Telecommunications Department of the Utility Operations
19	Division (Staff).
20	Q. Please describe your current responsibilities as a Regulatory Economist II.
21	A. I am responsible for reviewing and writing recommendations for
22	controversial or contested tariff and case filings. I am also responsible for reviewing
23	Missouri Universal Service Fund activities and assisting in Relay Missouri meetings and
24	activities. Also, I have been appointed by arbitrators to an advisory staff status to assist
25	the arbitrator in the decision-making process on unresolved issues in the negotiation of
26	interconnection agreements between SBC and various competitive local exchange
27	carriers.
28	Q. Please describe your educational background and employment history.

1	A. I hold a Bachelor of Science degree in Mathematics from Lincoln		
2	University in Jefferson City, Missouri. I was employed by Missouri Power and Light		
3	Company from 1973 to 1983 as Supervisor of Rates, Regulations and Budgeting. I was		
4	employed by United Water Missouri as Commercial Manager from 1983 to 2000. I		
5	began employment at the Commission in June 2000.		
6	Q. Have you previously testified before the Commission?		
7	A. Yes.		
8	Q. What is the purpose of your testimony?		
9	A. The purpose of my testimony is to present rates, calling scopes and		
10	statistics in response to the request by the Office of Public Counsel that the Commission		
11	consider modifying the Kansas City (KC) Metropolitan Calling Area (MCA) plan to		
12	make the Greenwood exchange part of the mandatory KC MCA Tier 2. The primary		
13	issue in this case is the reclassification of the Greenwood exchange from an optional KC		
14	MCA Tier 3 exchange to a mandatory KC MCA Tier 2 exchange.		
15	Q. What is your understanding of the change of the Greenwood exchange to a		
16	mandatory MCA Tier 2 status?		
17	A. Currently, there are approximately ** <u>HC</u> -** access lines in the		
18	Greenwood exchange. Greenwood is classified in Rate Group B of SBC's tariff. The		
19	rates for this group reflect (1) basic local charges for residential customers (\$8.79) and		
20	business customers (\$22.30); (2) an additive for subscribers to the MCA plan (residential		
21	\$12.35, business \$24.80); and (3) an additional additive for extended area service		
22	(residential \$.10, business \$.29) for Greenwood exchange customers to call the Lee		
23	Summit exchange and the Belton Zone. OPC's request (if granted) outlines that

1	customers in the Greenwood exchange would pay the Tier 2 rate of \$12.07 for residential				
2	services and \$38.50 for business services and eliminates the additional additive for MCA				
3	service or additional EAS service. However, OPC has indicated in their Final				
4	Recommendation filed April 29, 2005, that it would consider an additive not to exceed				
5	\$2.00 month for residential and \$3.00 month for business customers as a possible price				
6	adjustment under these unique "annexation" circumstances. Schedule 1 outlines SBC's				
7	existing rates for residential and business service and also outlines OPC's request for				
8	residential and business services, including the consideration of the \$2.00 price				
9	adjustment for residential customers and the \$3.00 price adjustment for business				
10	customers.				
11	Q. What is the current take rate for MCA subscribers in the Greenwood				
12	exchange?				
13	A. Schedule 2 outlines the MCA take rate for MCA subscribers in the				
14	Greenwood exchange. This information was supplied by SBC in a data request to Staff				
15	and covers the April 2005 timeframe. Schedule 2 outlines the total access lines served by				
16	SBC, MCA access lines, non-MCA access lines and the MCA take rate. The residential				
17	take rate for MCA service is ** <u>HC</u> ** The business take rate for MCA service is				
18	** <u>HC</u> **				
19	Q. If OPC's proposal is approved, will Greenwood exchange customers'				
20	calling scope be changed?				
21	A. Yes. Schedule 3 outlines the existing and proposed local calling scopes.				
22	As outlined in Schedule 3, all Greenwood exchange customers will experience a change.

In some cases, the local calling scope will be expanded and in some cases, the local calling scope will be smaller.

For existing non-MCA customers in the Greenwood exchange, the calling scope will be expanded to include all MCA Principal customers, Tier 1 and Tier 2 customers, and all MCA Tier 3, 4 and 5 subscribers. This significantly expands the calling scope for these customers because existing Greenwood non-MCA customers can currently only call all customers in the Greenwood exchange, Lee's Summit exchange customers and Belton zone customers as a local call.

9 For existing MCA customers in the Greenwood exchange, the calling scope will 10 become smaller under OPC's proposal. Currently, Greenwood MCA customers may call 11 all MCA Principal customers, Tier 1, Tier 2 and Tier 3 customers and all MCA Tiers 4 12 and 5 subscribers as a local call. Under OPC's proposal, Greenwood MCA customers 13 may call all MCA Principal customers, Tier 1 and Tier 2 customers, and all MCA Tier 3, 14 4 and 5 subscribers as a local call. OPC's proposal, if approved, creates a slightly smaller 15 toll-free calling scope because calls from an MCA Greenwood subscriber to non-MCA 16 subscribers in other Tier 3 exchanges will become a toll call. This difference may be 17 considered insignificant by many existing MCA Greenwood customers as long as MCA 18 subscribership in other Tier 3 exchanges remains high.

Q. What are the optional Tiers 3, 4 and 5 exchanges and the applicableincumbent local exchange carrier (ILEC) serving each exchange?

A. Schedule 4 outlines the ILEC exchanges served in each optional tier of the
Kansas City MCA area. There are six ILECs serving the optional KC MCA Tiers 3, 4
and 5.

1	Q. What is the take rate for optional Kansas City MCA Tiers 3, 4 and 5?
2	A. Schedule 5 outlines the percent of residential and business take rates for
3	Kansas City MCA Tiers 3, 4 and 5. The numbers and percentages are ILEC information
4	only and do not represent competitive local exchange carrier information.
5	Q. Please explain Schedule 6.
6	A. The exchanges associated with KC MCA are now competitive exchanges
7	under the provisions of SBC 237. Schedule 6 is provided for the Commission's
8	information as an easy source to review the competitive determination of each exchange.
9	Q. Does this conclude your Direct Testimony?
10	A. Yes, it does.
