


**REPLY OF THE MISSOURI INDUSTRIAL ENERGY CONSUMERS

Comes now The Boeing Company, DaimlerChrysler, Ford Motor Company, Hussmann Refrigeration, Monsanto Company and Pfizer, hereafter referred to as the Missouri Industrial Energy Consumers ("MIEC"), and pursuant to the Commission's October 16 order, files its Reply to the Commission Staff's October 31 Recommendation and to Missouri-American Water Company's November 10 Response to Staff Report.

The MIEC accepts Missouri-American Water Company's proposed Infrastructure System Replacement Charge as a percentage adjustment to total bill, with the revenue requirements adjustments recommended by the Commission Staff in its October 31 Recommendation.


