ORDER GRANTING EXTENSION OF TIME TO RESPOND

On August 3, 2006, the Missouri Public Service Commission issued its Order Approving Unanimous Stipulation and Consent Order in this case. In that order, among other things, the Commission directed its Staff to file a proposed compensation agreement for Mr. Cover's services as interim receiver on or before August 18, 2006.

On August 18, 2006, Staff filed a request seeking an extension until August 25, 2006, to file the proposed compensation agreement. In support of its request, Staff stated that discussions between Staff, the Cliffords and Mr. Cover have focused on steps necessary to transfer responsibility from the Cliffords as soon as practicable and they were only able to briefly discuss Mr. Cover's compensation. Further, according to Staff, Mr. Cover was on vacation August 14-18 and was unavailable to further discuss proposals for his compensation.

The request for extension of time is reasonable and will be granted.

IT IS ORDERED THAT:

1. The Commission Staff will file with the Commission a proposed compensation agreement for Mr. Cover's services as interim receiver on or before August 25, 2006.
2. This order shall become effective on August 18, 2006.
